

City of Ottumwa Urban Deer Hunt Proficiency Test

2022-2023 Deer Season

This test is used to show a hunters proficiency with a bow and arrow. This test consists of ten (10) arrows shot at an 8-inch target at a distance of twenty (20) yards. Eight (8) arrow hits out of ten (10) shot within the 8-inch target passes the test. The hunter may only take this test one time in a 24 hour period, and a maximum of three (3) times per season. If a hunter is unable to pass this test after three (3) attempts, the hunter will not be able to qualify for the respective season.
